J Video Games

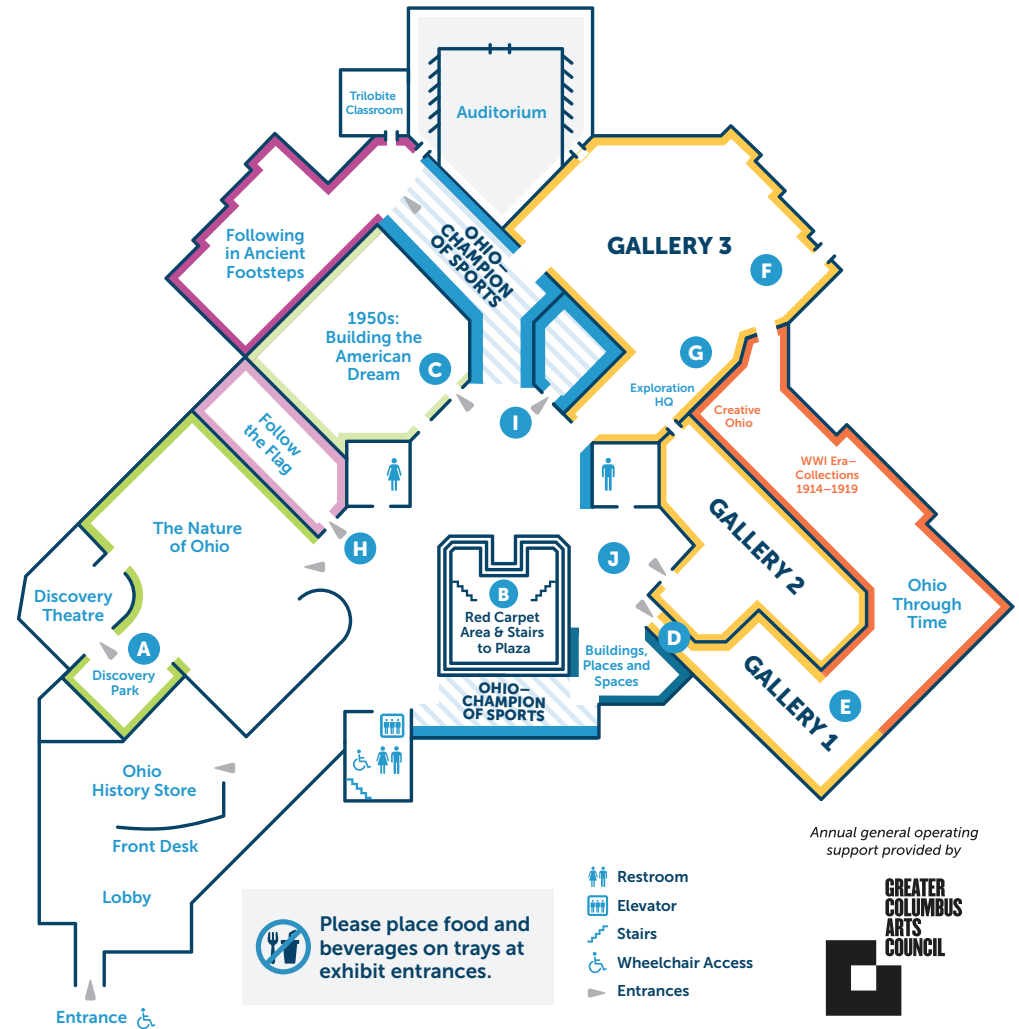
Try some retro games with some retro consoles and learn about this change in gaming history!
