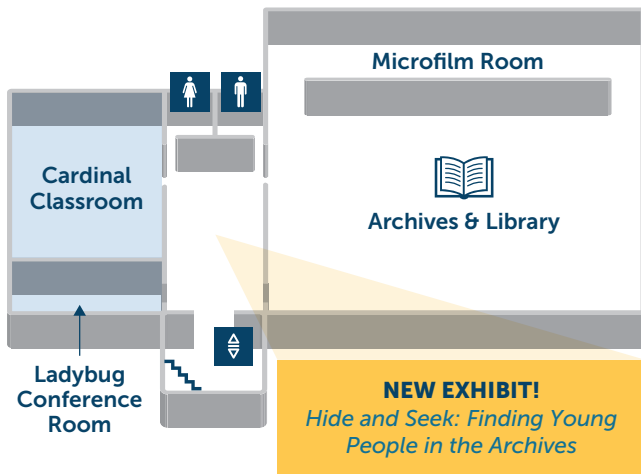


OHIO HISTORY CENTER MUSEUM MAP

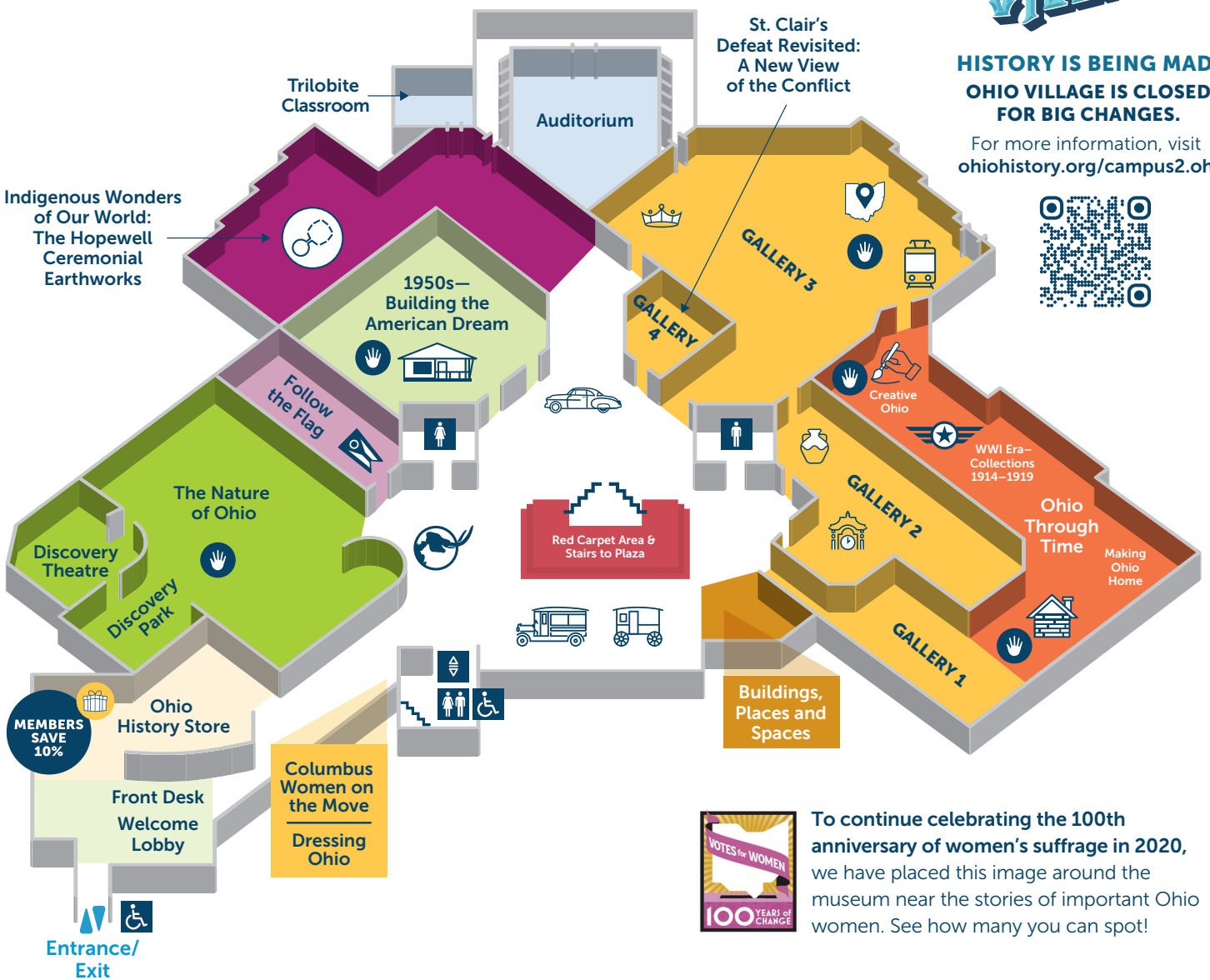
